**RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGEING BALANCE BILLING FOR EMERGENCY
MEDICAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Hanover Township Fire District #3 in the County of Morris, invoices all patients transported in ambulances operated by the Board of Fire Commissioners, and;

WHEREAS, the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services has issued an opinion that allows a government agency to accept property taxes in-lieu of balance billing patients;

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District Number Three, Township of Hanover, County of Morris, N.J., as follows:

1. Beginning January 1, 2013, the Fire District will begin balance billing any EMS patient, who does not reside within the boundaries of Hanover Township Fire District #3, transported by ambulances operated by the Fire District.
2. Beginning January 1, 2013, the Fire District will not balance bill any member of the Fire District and/or his or her immediate family should they be transported by ambulances operated by the Fire District.
